More than 40,000 Respond to First Poll

With the election up for grabs, GodTube.com to become major resource for media as first nationwide Christian polling reveal initial surprising results with Mike Huckabee first choice among Christians, followed by Barack Obama

DALLAS, TX – January 28, 2008 – GodTube.com, the website which set the record as the #1 fastest growing website in the U.S. according to ComScore during its first official launch month, announces it will conduct ongoing election polling for the 2008 presidential race.
